The two companies were "joined" in the late 1960's through their separate acquisition by Servotronics, Inc. and now form the Cutlery Products Group of Servotronics.

Through the first 3/4 of the 20th century, Ontario concentrated its efforts on kitchen cutlery through the famous Old Hickory brand of kitchen knives. However, since the early 1970's, Ontario has expanded its product lines and markets to include a broad range of sporting/outdoor knives in addition to becoming the largest supplier of galley and small arms cutlery to the United States military. 
Ontario County Hunting Knives

The beautiful Finger Lakes Region in upstate New York includes Ontario County. Each knife is named after a Finger Lake.


The Ontario County Hunting Knives are made with the same skill and care that was common in the late 19th Century, when the company was founded. These knives continue a point of view that a knife should be admired not only for its cutting ability but for its appearance, and a tradition that fine knives be passed on for others to use and admire.

Each knife features a brush finished, 440A stainless steel blade, a stacked leather and fiber handle, a brass guard, and a stag cap. Each knife comes with a dark, tanned leather sheath and is packed in an attractive gift box. All knives and sheaths are made in the U.S.A.



U.S. MILITARY KNIVES

PRESENTATION GRADE

Working military knives in presentation grade, "dress uniforms" make beautiful gifts, handsome additions to collections and excellent, general purpose field knives. Knife features include brush finished, 440A stainless steel blades, stacked leather and fiber handles, and brass guards and buttcaps. Each knife includes a tanned non-corrosive leather sheath and comes in an attractive gift box.

U.S.M.C. PARACHUTIST KNIFE

The original Parachutist Knife, pictured below, was used by trainees at Marine jump schools during WW II to cut tangled parachutes and equipment. The knife was issued for jump school only and was to be turned in when training was complete. Original Parachutist Knives are rare and quite valuable.

U.S.N. MARK I UTILITY KNIFE

Navy Mark 1's were issued to sailors for general utility use aboard ship. Many varieties of this popular World War II knife were manufactured; there was wide variation in blade grinds, handle materials and shapes. The new, presentation grade Mark 1 has a slightly shorter blade than the original version. 4-3/4" vs. 5-1/8"

U.S. ARMY QUARTERMASTER KNIFE

The Army Quartermaster Knife was not just a cutting knife. The thick, wide blade was used as a pry bar for opening shipping crates, and the blunt end was used as a hammer. These knives were also "traded" to WWII infantry troops and used in combat. The civilian version was marketed under the more adventurous name, Commando Knife.





Queen Cutlery is located in Titusville, Pennsylvania, about two hours Northeast of Pittsburgh, Pa. All Queen products are made at the Titusville factory. Most other functions - sales, customer service, accounting, etc. - are located at the Ontario Knife factory in Franklinville, N.Y. - about two hours away.

Queen's roots go back to the Schatt and Morgan Cutlery Company, which was founded in Gowanda, N.Y. in 1890 and moved to Titusville in 1895. Queen is still housed in the original Schatt and Morgan factory and many of the delicate hand processes and operations employed by Schatt and Morgan are still being used by Queen. Skilled craftsmen are essential to build a "factory knife" by hand and, while this doesn't lead to mass production or extremely low prices, the results are beautiful, functional knives. Painted Crown Red

A delicate, time consuming process is followed to develop the deep, "royal" red handles on these beautiful knives. Each handle slab is shaped from a sheet of bright red acrylic. Then the back of each handle is painted a deep blue. The combination of the red acrylic and blue paint results in the royal, rich color of Painted Crown Red. Each knife includes a new, black painted shield and Queen Steel blades.





SCHATT & MORGAN POCKETKNIVES

The Schatt and Morgan Cutlery Company was founded in 1890. The company produced very high quality pocketknives until it was purchased by the Queen City Cutlery Company in 1932. Queen City changed it's name to the Queen Cutlery Company in 1947 and started making Queen Steel knives at about the same time. Queen Cutlery is still housed in the original Schatt and Morgan factory in Titusville, Pa.

Schatt and Morgan Series I pocketknives were introduced in 1991, with Series II, III and IV following through 1994. At the beginning of the year the new series is started and the old series discontinued. The make-up of each series has been:

- * Series I 1991 Brown jigged bone, six knives, introductory year.
- * Series II 1992 Deep red jigged bone, eight knives, two new patterns.
- * Series III 1993 Winterbottom bone, six knives, two new, one revised pattern.
- * Series IV 1994 Corncob bone, six knives, two new, two revised patterns.

Given the time and skill necessary to produce these beautiful, premium quality knives, production has been, and will be, limited to less than 1,000 pieces per year. The knives typically sell out in the summer.

SCHATT & MORGAN POCKETKNIFE SERIES V

The fifth year of the Schatt and Morgan reproductions is a milestone and this event is marked by the introduction of a new trapper pattern and the use of special handle materials - burnt stag and pearl - on the new Schatt and Morgan Series V Pocketknives. Additional features include:

- * Queen Steel blades, with traditional grinds.
- * Nickel silver liners on the Doctor's knife. Brass liners on the other four patterns.
- * Year of manufacture '95 tang stamped. All secondary blades tang stamped.
- Decorated nickel silver bolsters.
- * All shields pinned to handles.





SCHATT & MORGAN POCKETKNIFE ANNIVERSARY SERIES V

Special handle materials and a new Trapper pattern mark the fifth anniversary of the Schatt and Morgan reproductions. The Doctor's Knife is handled in white, presentation grade pearl and, to highlight the pearl, nickel silver liners and a nickel silver center scale are used instead of brass. A new, decorative blade etch is also used on the Doctor's Knife. The new Sway Belly Trapper, Cotton Knife, Swing Guard Lockback and Canoe Whittler are handled in stag, which is lightly burnt to enrich the color.



Strawberry Bone

The Robeson Cutlery Company was founded in 1879, by Millard Robeson. The company continued to manufacture knives until 1965 and continued to sell knives until 1971, when the cutlery business was purchased by The Ontario Knife Company, the sister company of Queen Cutlery. Robeson produced many handsome knives during it's long history, but the company was best known for beautiful, red handled knives made with Strawberry Bone.





Rawhide Series


Handsome, durable staminawood handles, with pinned nickel silver shields, are featured in the Rawhide Series. Staminawood offers the look and texture of fine natural wood with the strength of high impact plastic. Sheaths included with fixed blade hunters.





Amber Collection

The rich appearance of the amber colored handles is improved with nickel silver shields pinned to the handles. All knives feature durable Delrin handles and Queen Steel blades except the Jumbo 83A, which is made of carbon steel.





Chipped Bark


The jigged handles on this popular line resemble the texture and color of tree bark and silver, cast nickel shields are pinned to the handles. Each knife includes Queen Steel blades, Delrin handles, nickel silver bolsters, and brass liners. Most popular, traditional patterns are included in this series.





Red Ice


"Cracked Ice" was a very popular handle material that, due to technical reasons, was discontinued by Queen Steel years ago. The technical problems have been solved and a red color has been added to produce Red Ice. Five popular patterns feature famous Queen Steel blades and pinned, nickel silver shields.





Burnt Bone


Smooth white bone is lightly burned to produce the handsome, rich handle color on these popular knife patterns. The nickel silver Queen shield is pinned to the handle. Club knife and collector quality at reasonable prices.





Button Locks/Hunters/Fillet

The lock releases by pushing a small button on the bolster - minimal pressure required. One of the easiest locking mechanisms available. Chipped Bark handles with cast nickel silver shields pinned to handles. Queen Steel blades.





Traditional Folders






