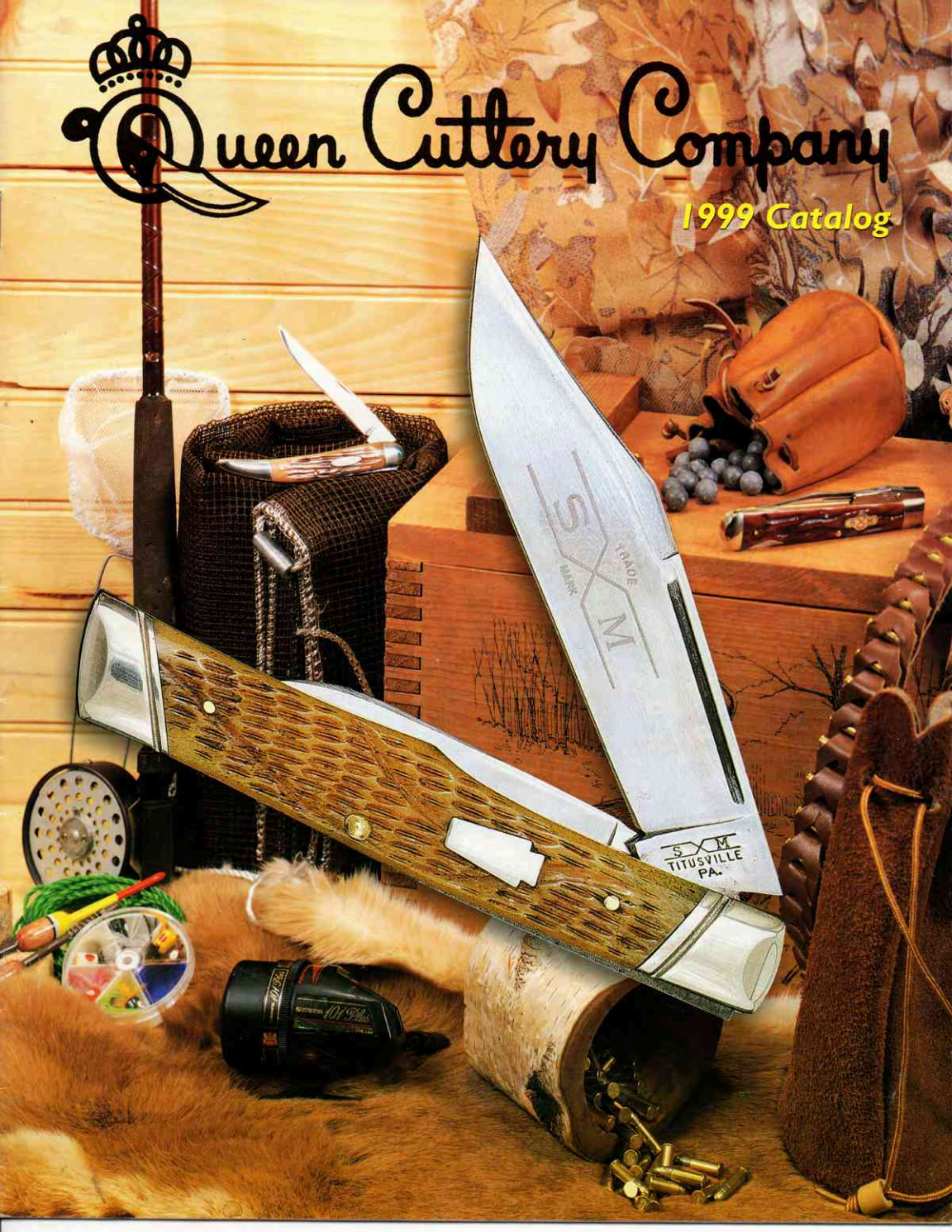

The old Schatt & Morgan and Robeson companies certainly took Great Grandpa's requirements to heart. We, at Queen, still do. Just as the old pocketknives were built for durability as well as looks, we have carried on the tried and true traditions of solid brass liners, nickel silver bolsters, stainless steel pins and first-class fit and finish. Queen's special proprietary QS14 Steel has long been a proven winner.

Queen Cutlery is transitioning to ATS34 Stainless Steel in many of its pocketknives. ATS34 combines the "pretty" with "performance". With your Queen, Schatt & Morgan, and Robeson, you will receive the superior edge holding quality of high carbon steel and the anti-tarnishing benefits of stainless steel. Great Grandpa would have been pleased. If Great Grandpa were still with us, we are confident he would buy one of our new pocketknives and put his old one, as good as it was, in a drawer. No fool he!

Our mission is to keep making Great Grandpa proud and in so doing, you as our customer will continue to reap the benefits. 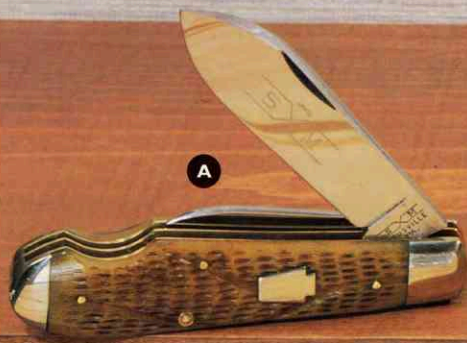

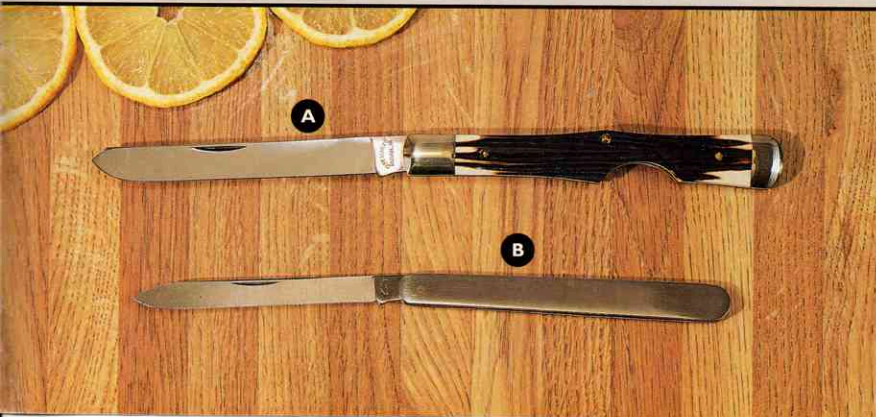

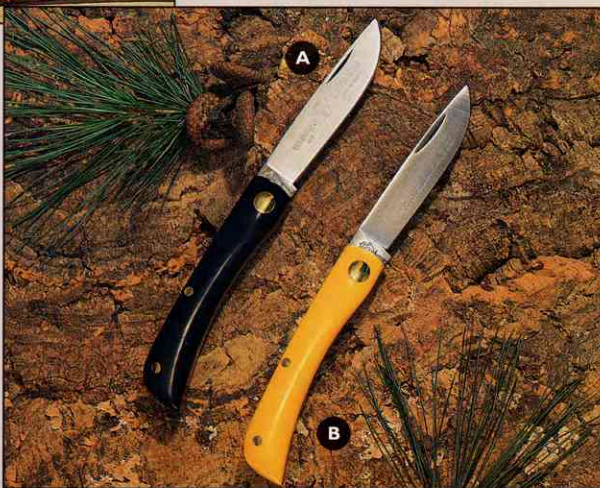
