## **History of the Queen Cutlery Company**

The cover of this folder includes the major dates and trademarks in the evolution of the Queen Cutlery Company.

Schatt and Morgan Cutlery was organized in 1890 in Gowanda, N.Y. by it's founders, J.W. Schatt and C.B. Morgan. In 1895 the company moved to Titusville, PA. The company made very high quality pocket and hunting knives.

Queen City was founded in 1918 by employees of Schatt and Morgan. The name Queen City was selected because oil had been discovered in Titusville and the city had become known as the "Queen City." Since the company devoted 100% of it's production to contract manufacturing the company operated without an official name until 1922. While Queen City prospered during the 1920's Schatt and Morgan did not and in 1930 Schatt and Morgan was broke. In 1932 Queen City purchased Schatt and Morgan and operations were consolidated in the Schatt and Morgan factory.

Queen City continued to make knives with carbon steel blades through the 1930's. In the early 1940's the company began to experiment with stainless steel and in 1945/46 began to replace carbon steel with stainless steel blades. Since stainless steel blades were controversial the company decided to call this material "Queen Steel" and registered this trademark in 1947. Also in 1947 the company changed it's name from Queen City Cutlery Company to Queen Cutlery Company. Queen Cutlery still occupies the original Schatt & Morgan factory and all knives made by Queen are manufactured at this location.

While many cutlery companies have adopted more automated manufacturing Queen Cutlery takes pride in using many of the original, hand operations utilized by both Schatt and Morgan and Queen City. Over 150 hand operations are required to make the average Queen pocket knife and about 200 operations are required to make the Schatt and Morgan reproductions.

# Amber Collection

The rich appearance of the amber colored handles is improved with nickel silver shields pinned to the handles. All knives feature durable Delrin handles and Queen Steel blades except the Jumbo 83A, which is made of carbon steel.
